The focus of the conference will be on discussions with members to develop ideas and plans for EFN's future activities. There will be two speakers prompting thoughts about how and why a network can operate.

Individuals and representatives of organisations who are not members of EFN should pay conference attendance fees - €40 for individuals and €120 for representatives of organisations. These payments can be counted as membership fees after the conference if the person or organisation wishes.

NOTE: payment is by €uros only. Please be aware that you may incur a currency conversion charge from your bank or credit card if you are paying in €uros from a non-€uro account.

Registration begins on Thursday 28 November at 11.30 and the conference programme begins at 14.00 until 17.00.

There will be tea and coffee available on this day but no lunch - please find your own lunch before the programme begins.

There will be a musical performance in the evening.
